The unique attractive landscape of Kendal and its environs is a very important attribute of Kendal which benefits not just the quality of life for its residents but also its attractiveness for tourists.

The pictures below show the importance of the Kendal-Oxenholme Green Gap in contributing to this unique landscape attractiveness, and what would be lost by the suggested developments.



The panorama below shows how the suggested building development in the Green Gap - and especially in M2M in this view - would destroy much of the purpose of the green gap to separate Oxenholme in the foreground from Kendal, and shows how the green gap at present visually connects up with the green gap between Oxenholme and Natland.



The following pages provide 2 “zoom-ins” from the same viewpoint on The Helm.

The suggested M2M development would occupy the field below left of centre (and a field nearer but largely hidden).
